To make this vision a reality, CCC undertook the *Raising Voices Campaign*, a three-year, \$12 million comprehensive fundraising initiative to expand CCC's choral programs throughout Chicago, offer incredible artistic opportunities to our students, and establish an endowment to secure our financial future. The 2017-18 program year marked the public phase of the campaign, and we are grateful to share that your generous support allowed us to exceed our \$12 million goal. Thank you for investing in one of Chicago's most notable approaches to youth development, in an organization that has served as a model for others throughout the country, and most importantly, in the place that raises the voices of Chicago's youth.

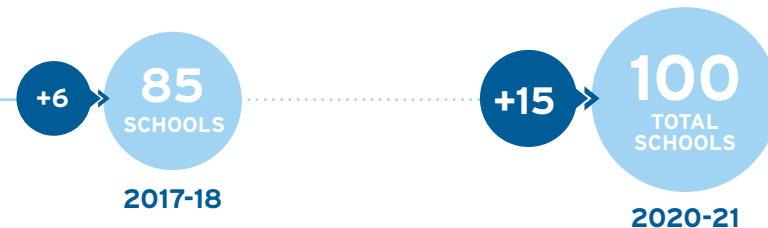

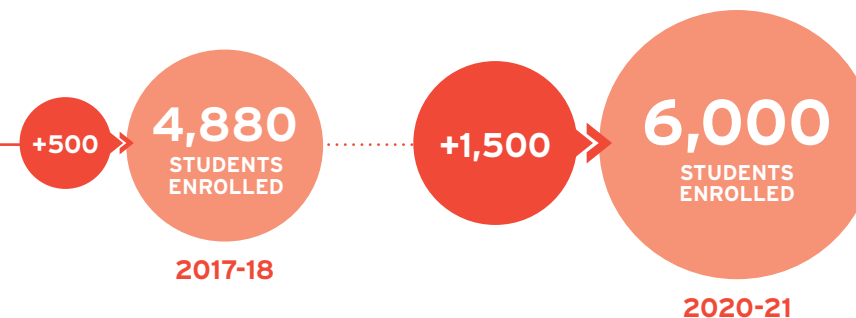

THE ELIZABETH MORSE CHARITABLE TRUST MATCHING GRANT CHALLENGE

CCC is grateful to The Elizabeth Morse Charitable Trust, which generously provided CCC with a two-year, \$500,000 matching grant challenge to seed our endowment with gifts from donors who normally support CCC's annual fund. For individuals who permanently restricted their annual fund contribution to CCC to our endowment, The Trust matched their gift dollar-for-dollar with unrestricted funds. For those who increased their contribution, The Trust matched their gift for more than 1:1 based on the donor's past three years of giving. As a result of the matching grant challenge, CCC raised over \$400,000 in cash gifts and \$100,000 in increased gifts for its endowment and received \$500,000 in unrestricted funds from The Trust.

PRESERVING OUR LEGACY

Since our founding in 1956, CCC has grown from a single choir into "an indispensable institution" (Howard Reich, *Chicago Tribune*) serving thousands of young people throughout Chicago. For the first time in our history, we have established an endowment to secure our financial future and support our programmatic vision, giving us the confidence to dream bigger and reach higher.

2017-18 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS



TARGET COMMUNITY CONCERT SERIES

CCC's Target Community Concert Series, an annual concert initiative, showcased all levels of CCC's programs through five concerts held throughout Chicago. Free and open to the public, the Target Community Concert Series featured hundreds of students from CCC's in-school and after-school programs in Pilsen/Little Village, Beverly, Englewood, Austin, Albany Park, and Hyde Park.



BLACK HISTORY MONTH CONCERT SERIES

CCC brought together more than 4,000 of our In-School Program students to Orchestra Hall to honor the history and contributions of the black community to our national heritage. Sponsored by Target, this immersive, interdisciplinary concert experience included historical lessons led by CCC's Associate Artistic Director Judy Hanson and performances from the stage by all In-School Program students. To accommodate our program growth, CCC added a third day to the series.

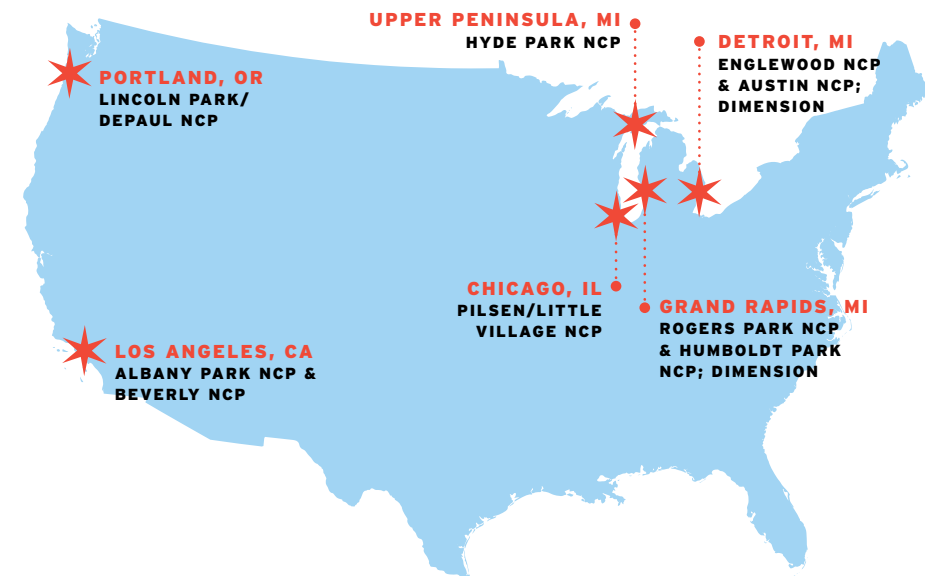


WORLD MUSIC FESTIVAL

CCC uses music as a vehicle for fostering intercultural understanding. By performing repertoire from other cultures, student embrace cultural difference while also recognizing the qualities that unite all people. In April, CCC brought together over 500 students from our after-school programs for the sixth annual World Music Festival. Students shared repertoire from over 10 countries and presented a concert in the Aon Grand Ballroom at Navy Pier featuring special guest artists, the Medicine Tail Singers.

BRINGING LONG WAY HOME TO MILLENNIUM PARK

As a central component of this year's Paint the Town Red concert, CCC presented a shortened version of *Long Way Home* featuring all actors and musicians from the world premiere. CCC students in the Pavilion sang and danced along to pieces from the show.

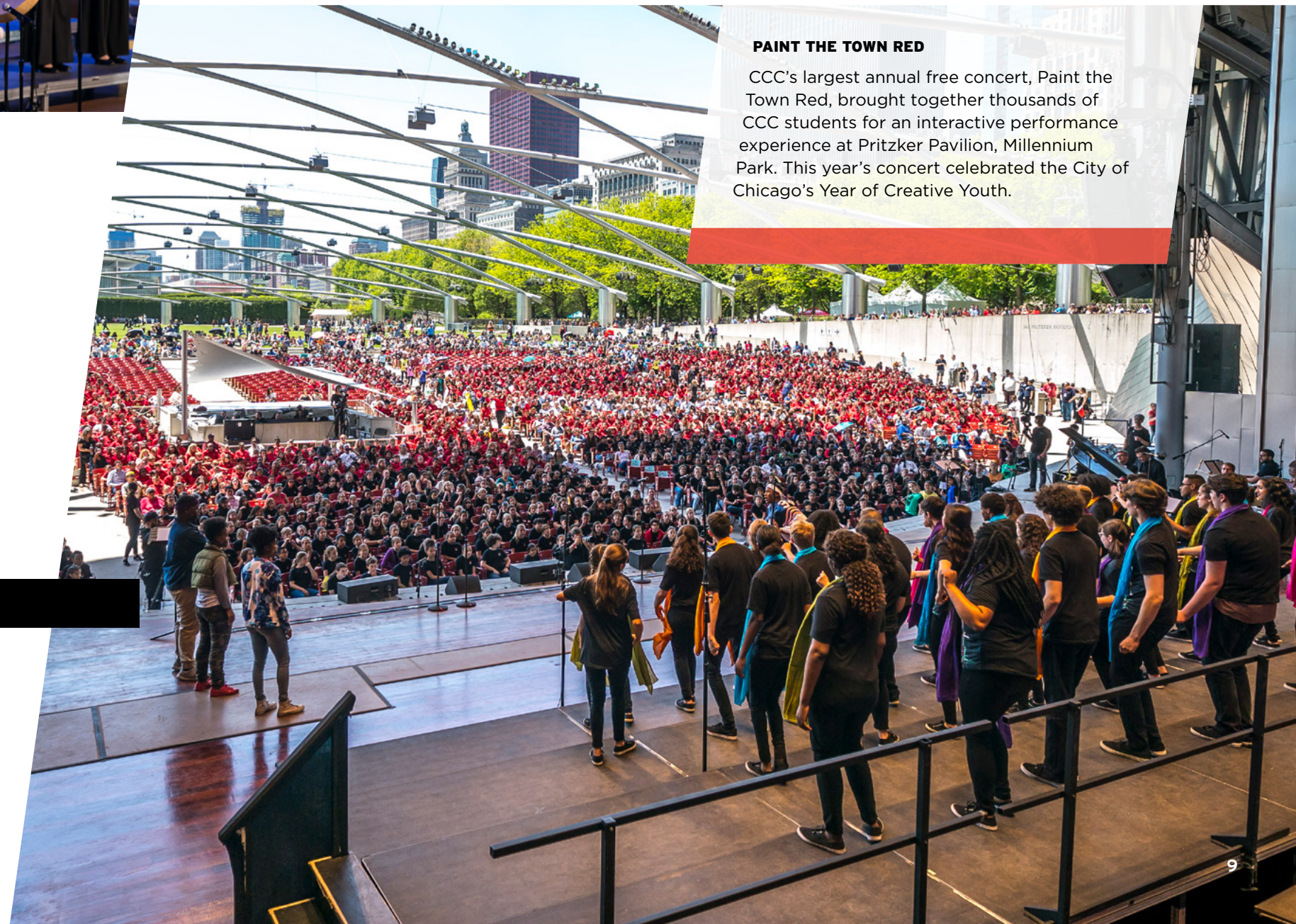


BRIDGING AMERICA TOURS

CCC's Bridging America Tours provided 240 students from the Neighborhood Choir Program (NCP) and DiDimension with the opportunity to spread CCC's mission throughout the United States.

PAINT THE TOWN RED

CCC's largest annual free concert, Paint the Town Red, brought together thousands of CCC students for an interactive performance experience at Pritzker Pavilion, Millennium Park. This year's concert celebrated the City of Chicago's Year of Creative Youth.

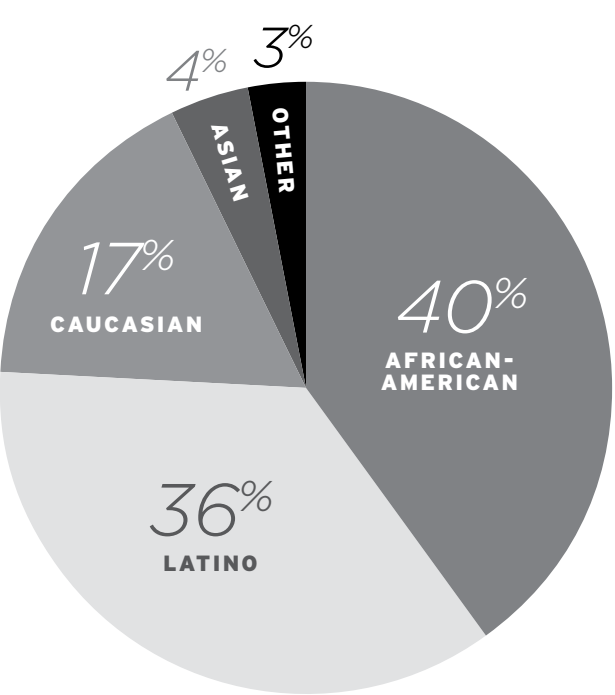

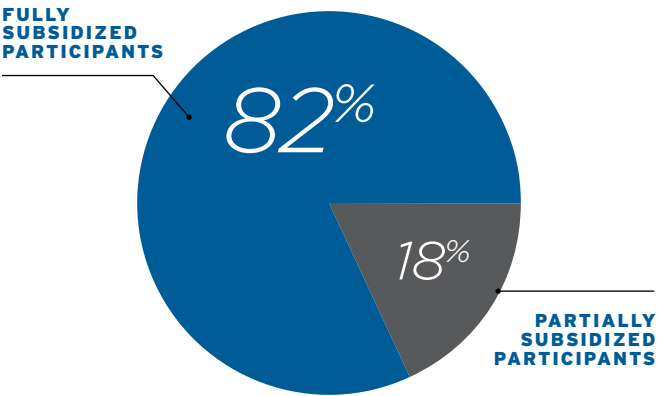
PROGRAM BREAKDOWN



CCC STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



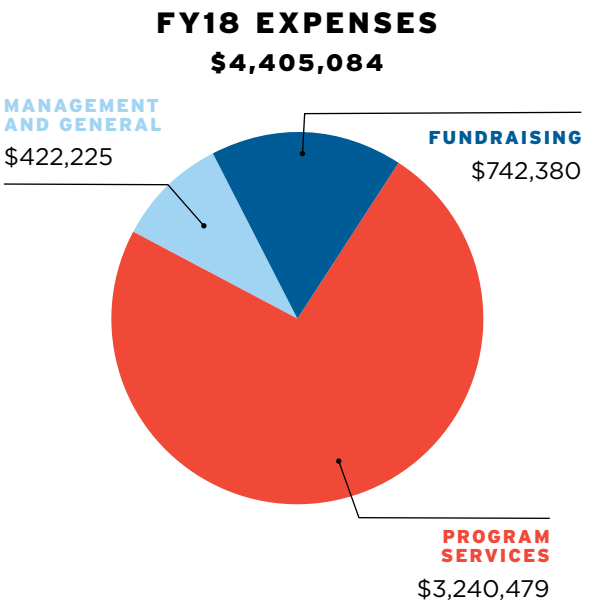
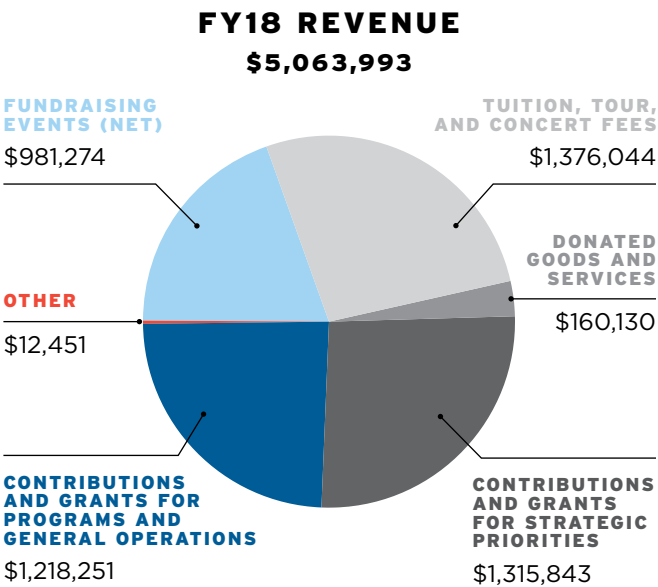

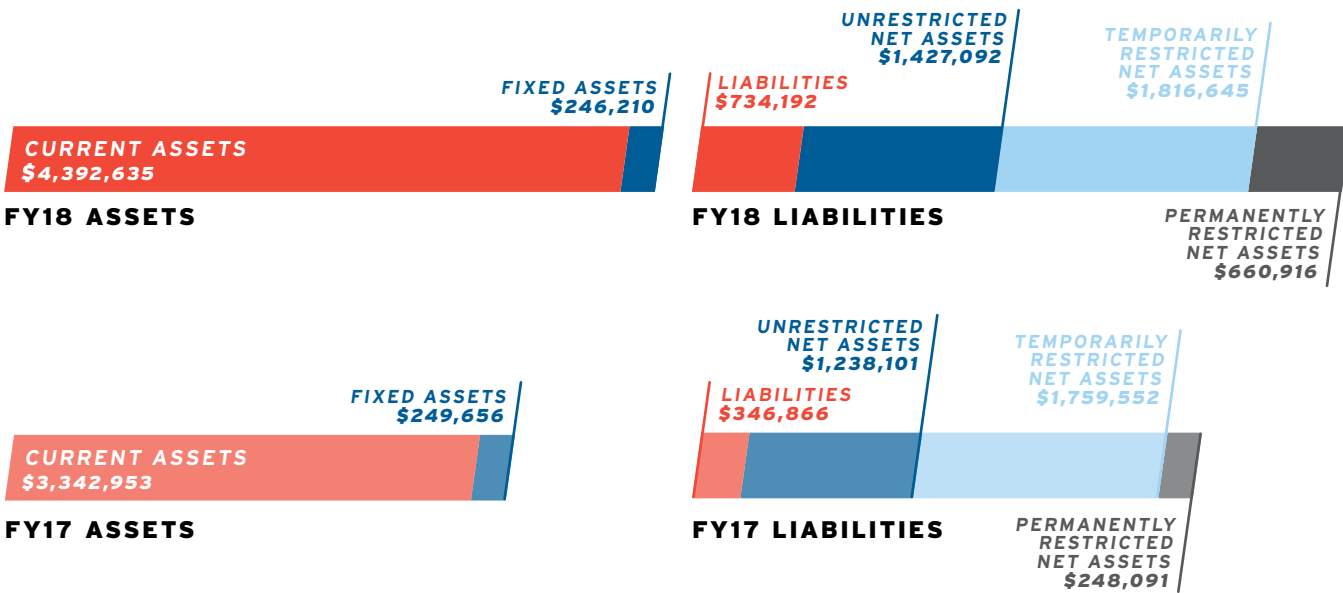
